### PAYMENT:

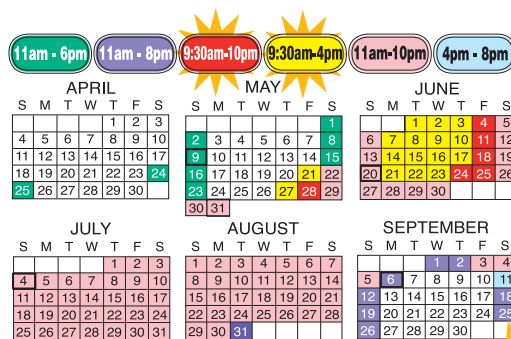

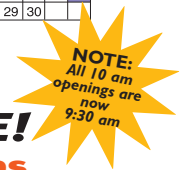
### FOOD:
